

There are two curriculum pathways available to students at Launceston College; **BLUE** and **GREEN**.


Both **BLUE** and **GREEN** curriculum pathways consist of compulsory courses which every student will study. These are;

- ✓ English Language and Literature
- ✓ Mathematics
- ✓ Dual Science
- ✓ Geography or History
- ✓ Physical Education (PE)
- ✓ Character lessons

#### **The Curriculum Pathways Form**

The Curriuclum Pathways Form allows students to select which subjects they wish to do. The google form your child receives will reflect these choices. This year the form is available from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February as a google form on ClassCharts.



#### Why are we focusing on 8 subjects?

- ✓ Higher grades are more important than a higher number of qualifications
- ✓ Over 200 hours extra over Year 10-11 for English, Maths, Science and Options compared to schools that do 9/10 subjects.
- ✓ More time for subjects brings better outcomes and better life chances.
- ✓ Even the Russell group universities only look at grades achieved rather than the number of qualifications.
- ✓ Students who don't achieve a grade 4 standard pass have to retake English and/or Maths in Year 12 and have reduced future career opportunities.



# Why are we suggesting the **BLUE** curriculum pathway students study a language?

- ✓ All students can opt to study a language
- ✓ Students in the top 50% of the cohort, based on nationally standardised testing, are expected to keep up a language until 16, just as in most countries globally.

'A study by the UCL Institute of Education shows that studying Languages provides students with greater opportunities in further education and increases the likelihood that a pupil will stay on in full-time education.'



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# Curriculum Pathways – 2024 HUMANITIES



Compulsory Subjects
All students will study the core subjects; mathematics, English, science, either history or geography, PE, RE and IAG, alongside their options. Following the introduction of the English Baccalaureate, most students will study a language as well as 2 option subjects.

# Curriculum Pathways – 2024 **SCIENCE**



All students will study **AQA Trilogy Combined Science** which covers biology, chemistry and physics across two GCSEs.

Combined Science is a suitable course for those students who wish to progress to A-levels in science subjects such as biology, chemistry, physics, geology and applied science.




It is not guaranteed that all students will get the subjects they wish but we do write our curriculum specifically each year on what the students request.

Monday 11th March.








