**IMPORTANT POST-16 TRANSPORT INFORMATION**  
**We advise that you do not delay in organising your transport.**

You and your parents/carers need to consider how you will travel to and from the Sixth Form at Launceston College. If you require transport you will need to apply to your relevant council. Applications are now open for the new academic year. You may be able to use the 'Vacant Seat' or 'Concessionary Rider' schemes provided by your council, however you will need to apply for this, as a seat on the bus does not automatically continue from Year 11 into Sixth Form.

**Important: Before you apply – students travelling by bus**

Please be aware that ticket products available direct from bus companies working together under the Transport for Cornwall Partnership (TfC) will now offer more value for money and be available at a lower cost than bus passes provided through the Council's Post 16 Transport Scheme in many cases. The benefits include the ability for all under-19s to travel for half the price of an adult fare across all services operated by multiple bus companies. Applications must be made by **Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2024** in order for students to receive their travel pass/arrangements for the start of the Autumn Term. Please note that travel passes/arrangements will not be issued until your first term's payment contribution is received (if required). Payment contributions must be made by **Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2024** in order for students to receive their travel pass/arrangements for the start of the Autumn Term.

Applications and payments received after the deadlines above will be processed as soon as possible. However, where either the application or payment is late, we cannot guarantee that travel arrangements will be in place for the start of the Autumn Term. Students will need to make their own travel arrangements in the meantime.

There is a charge from your council for post-16 transport. We have vulnerable and discretionary bursary funding available, the eligibility criteria for the bursaries is included in your enrolment pack, along with a bursary application form should you wish to apply. Please read the bursary information as you may be able to claim reimbursement of the transport cost from the College bursary depending on your own family circumstances.

Launceston College operates a mini-bus from the centre of Holsworthy direct to College which you need to book with the Sixth Form team, before the last day of term. The cost of the mini bus is equivalent to a bus pass from your local council, however the post-16 bursary can be used to cover this cost for eligible students.

Students and their parents/carers will be responsible for arranging transport to College on time until a seat allocation has been made.
