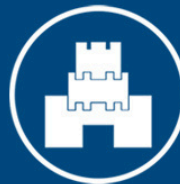

Component 1 – Devising

Non-examination assessment 40% of the qualification

Component 2 – Text in Performance

Non-examination assessment 20% of the qualification

Component 3 – Theatre Makers in Practice

Written examination 40% of the qualification

Unit descriptions:

Component 1:

- Devise an original performance piece.
- Use one key extract from a performance text and a theatre practitioner as stimuli.
- Produce a portfolio analysing and evaluating the rehearsal and performance process.

Component 2:

- A group performance/design realisation of one key extract from a performance text.
- A monologue or duologue performance/design realisation from one key extract from a different performance text.

Component 3:

- Practical exploration and study of a complete performance text.
- Live theatre evaluation.

Entry Requirements:

5 GCSE's 5 - 9 including a minimum of grade 6 in English and Drama. We would consider individual cases of students who haven't previously studied GCSE Drama. A grade 6 in English is essential.

Possible progression routes:

There are many routes available to you if you take A-Level theatre studies both as university courses or apprenticeship schemes; acting, law, advertising, broadcasting, therapy, sales, public relations or teaching.
