Unit titles: A level personal investigation (01) A level externally set task (02)

The A-level Art and Design course is a two year program that encourages students to explore their creativity, develop technical skills, and build a personal body of work. It is designed for those with a strong interest in visual art and aims to deepen understanding of materials, techniques, and concepts across a wide range of artistic disciplines.

Unit descriptions: Personal investigation: Non-exam assessment (internally assessed and externally moderated). Students should produce a portfolio of practical work in response to a brief, scenario or stimulus provided by the student or centre, and a related written study of at least 1000 words. 120 marks 60%

Externally set task: 15 hours non-exam assessment (internally assessed and externally moderated). Students produce a response to one of a number of provided themes, each of which will have a range of written and visual starting points, briefs and stimuli. 80 marks 40%

Entry Requirements: Art GCSE grade 6, English GCSE grade 5.

Possible progression routes: Higher education degree courses in, fine art, architecture, film, illustration, graphics and all other art related degrees and careers in the creative industries.

Equipment required: Pencils, paint, sketchbooks etc. There will be opportunities to visit galleries and exhibitions for which there maybe a small cost
