## Extra Curricular Opportunities

In the Sixth form at Launceston College there are many opportunities to take part in, or organise, extra curricula activities.

Here are just a few of them:

### *Feeling Active?*



Take part in the Ten Tors Challenge—a weekend challenge run by the army, to cover a specified distance over Dartmoor's rugged terrain.

### *Want to try something different?*



Take part in the Devizes to Westminster Canoe Race— A 4 day canoe race over 125 miles along the Kennet and Avon canal and down the Thames to Westminster Bridge.

### *Want to help others as well?*



As a sixth form student you can start with the Gold Award, even if you have never done Bronze or Silver. The award consists of physical activities, but also volunteering, learning a new skill, and a residential.

### *Do you enjoy the creative arts?*

You don't need to be studying drama to take part in our school productions, you can act, direct, choreograph, paint scenery, etc. whatever is your forte.
