Personal Investigation:

Non-exam assessment

(Internally assessed and externally moderated).

Students should produce a portfolio of practical work in response to a brief, scenario or stimulus provided by the student or centre, and a related written study of at least 1000 words. 120 marks 60%

Externally Set Task:

15 hours non-exam assessment (internally assessed and externally moderated). Students produce a response to one of a number of provided themes, each of which will have a range of written and visual starting points, briefs and stimuli. 80 marks 40%

Entry Requirements:

Maths GCSE grade 5 ,English GCSE grade 5

Possible progression routes:

Higher education degree courses in, photography, film, animation and all other photography related degrees and careers in the creative industries

Camera, sketchbook etc
